
I have spent more than three-quarters of my life in the cycle trade, and now with Grant by my side, I am still getting as much pleasure as ever from greeting cyclists.

With craftsmanship of a former era, Condor are proud to present a triplet of frames on which artistic excellence and craft skills have been given free rein.

In keeping with the traditions of half a century ago, we have given fresh life to traditional Condor lug designs.

Starting with top quality steel plain lugs, fork crown and brake bridge, each with the finishing touches which have always given Condor hand-cut lugged machines the elegance for which they have become world-famous.

Racing or touring, your frame can be built with these hand-cut lugs, each set being carefully feathered during frame building.

There are three styles:

Superbe – the most elegant, a masterpiece of metal sculpture.

No 1 – a classic timeless design.

Elite – subtle simplicity with class.

Your frame price will include braze-ons to choice, finish to choice (yes, even metallic!) and contrasting lug lining. Chromium plating on head lugs and fork crown, half front forks, and half rear stays, will only apply to models *Superbe* and *No 1*.



Tradition with innovation

Condor's world tourer, a frame ready for serious riding, ample clearances, and everything brazed-on

Condor – Special Cadet

Probably the oldest Condor name, the Special Cadet is a concept which has been developed over more than 45 years, to answer every demand made by the accomplished tourist.

Anne Mustoe, a Suffolk schoolmistress, has just completed a tour of the five continents on our latest model.

There is still no greater test than this for the excellence of a bike's design and integrity.

So what do you get?

There's a choice of tubing – we believe in the classic Reynolds 531ST (Special Tourist) but we have recently completed a Special Cadet in 753.

Our design is conservative, 72 degree parallel frame (note slight variation on sizes) with ample clearance for 700 x 35mm tyres and appropriate fork off-set to provide responsiveness with loaded stability.

For particular needs we will make the Special Cadet with your choice of angles.

Nothing needs to be clipped on: cantilever bosses are standard though you may prefer alternative brazed clips for hub brakes or even for a Pentasport coaster five speed.

There are brazings for two bottle cages, pump peg and rear carrier. Low-rider formation at the front, if requested. One option is a brazed-on boss for a bottle dynamo on the seat stay, most of our customers prefer under-bracket dynamos.

Naturally, Reynolds 16mm seat stays are used, the most rigid that the company produces, in order to give the strength needed with the longer rear triangle that long-distance touring demands.

Sheer speed, sure handling, pure delight

Balanced-built low profile racing frames for the specialist, with straight or uniquely-curved tubing for extra response

Condor – Ultimo

Low profile frames are the style for pure speed racing, whether this be a time trial, a pursuit or a road record.

As every connoisseur knows, the lighter and more responsive it is, so must a frame be correctly balanced, in order to be able to answer the needs of the cyclist.

Condor has always been an innovator with ultra-short-wheelbase frames, with the result that low-profile machines came naturally to Condor builders, and our latest frames are probably the best in the world.

It is all the result of balance.

They are so light and rigid that they break records and win titles, yet they are so carefully-built that you can ride them 'hands-off' – and without boasting, that is more than you can do with some others!

Start with the latest combinations, unique to Condor, and based on Reynolds tubing.

Lightweight Italian engraved lugs, exclusively-crafted for low profile frames, may be used with Reynolds straight tubing, or with a Reynolds top tube that has been exclusively curved to Condor's own specification.

Complementing these two unique frames is an all-welded machine, made from a matching set of Columbus SL curved top and seat tubes, which provides optimum 'tuck-under' for the rear wheel.

Standard 700c wheels, or 26" front – 24" for very small frames – can be made to your specification.

Can we recommend integral aerodynamic fork crowns for these frames: if you are intending to use a front changer you should opt for a straight

seat tube – Condor low-profile frames will accept Shimano or Campagnolo eight speed freewheels.

These are frames ready to race – let us know if you want a brazed number plate boss – with only concealed cable routing being optional.



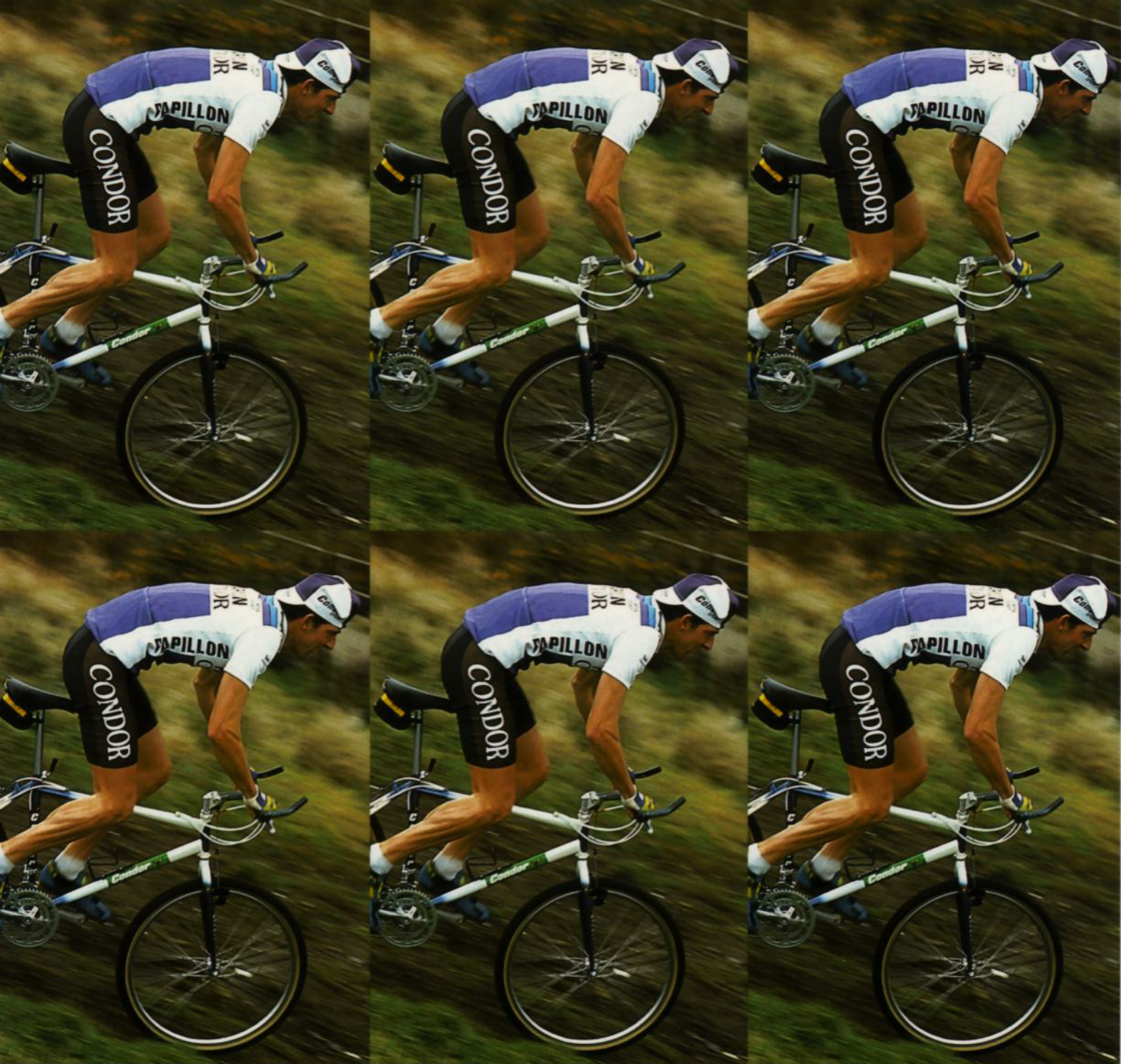

Innovative designs which take the guesswork out of off-road and city riding

Condor – ATBs

Here are frames which can really take the rough with the smooth, built by the craftsmen who regarded Paris-Roubaix and a six-day track as part of a day's work.

Condor ATBs are designed with serious off-roading in mind, they will stand up to the hurly-burly of everyday riding, and be immediately ready for a weekend in the hills.

Condor's traditional commitment to amateur and professional racing is already leading us to develop fresh initiatives in ATB frame design, innovations in construction which give you, the customer, absolute confidence in these frames' strength and safety.

Already our influence can be seen in the development of hybrid ATBs, strong enough to take rough roads in their stride, but with a new responsiveness when riding on tarmac.

You get a choice of tubing: Reynolds 531, 653, 753, oversized Magnum, Columbus, or Tange Prestige lightweight. All with brazed-joint strength and cast microfusion bottom bracket for supreme response when climbing.

For the demands of the specialist, all cable routings may be along the top tube, professional-style, with roller-cam front changer mounting.

We should appreciate it if you would let us know whether you intend to use your frame for off-road use, for road riding, or for ATB racing, and which size of tyre you are most likely to use.



Even a cursory glance through old Condor catalogues would show you that our frames have always been in the forefront of racing design, keeping pace with improvements in roads, tracks and gearing.

We have had a world pro pursuit champion with Hugh Porter, and success in Continental Sixes. Condor have acquitted themselves well in the classics, the Tour de France, the Peace Race,

the Milk Race and the Kellogg's Tour, as well as in the demanding city centre racing which asks so much of men and bikes.

Each of these events has called for a different type of frame, in angles, in clearances, in rigidity, lightness – calls which Condor has met and surpassed.

Total integrity in the new range of Condor Professional and Triathlon frames is assured through the use of Condor investment-cast lugs, specially cast in Italy to our order.

For each type of frame – and please tell us what your speciality is to be – we have different angles which have been carefully determined for the type of racing for which the frame is intended. Our Triathlon frames, for example, use a high-angle seat tube with hyper-stable front end to reduce fatigue.

Lugs, fork crown, bracket and even the specially-forged fork ends are all engraved to give that touch of distinction.

Cable eyes are normally on top of the top tube – an option is concealed routing – and there are brazed-on gear lever bosses, cable runs under the bracket, front changer hanger, chain-stay stop, and 2 sets of bottle cage bosses.

We can supply any other brazing to order. Condor fork crowns can be either aerodynamic sloping with integral lug, or sloping exposed lug, and frames made for the needs of women's racing are our speciality.

Sizes? To suit you: we have recently built an 18" racing frame, and a 32" whopper for the world's biggest cyclist!

Wheel be seeing you

WHEELS are what makes the difference to a bicycle. The finest frame, the peak of fitness, can all be undone if the wheels are not right, and at

Condors the wheels are built to last, to stay true, to run easily in the conditions for which they have been built. Is that Monty being cagey? No it is simply a statement of common sense, the 24-spoked wheels you might use in a smooth pursuit on the track, or a time trial, would be totally unsuitable for rough-riding or cyclo-cross. One can go even further and say that even for a track madison they would not be suitable if the track were to be steep.

So point number one when choosing wheels is to tell Monty what you expect to do with your Condor, where you expect to ride.

And wheels vary in price, though to Monty as much care will go into your utility wheels as into your racing wheels – they still have to carry you safely, and you are Monty's customer. So don't, and this is point number two, hesitate to say how much you can afford, Condor's enormous stocks can supply most needs for most pockets.

Point number three is simple – tell Condor's when you want the wheels, and make a date to pick them up; some customers like to order well in advance, others, for example, may need help just to get home from work after, perhaps, an accident.

There really is almost no limit to what you can have in wheels from ones suitable for a cross-country journey to Australia, to – yes we have made them – silk sprints for a gentle ride round Central Park, New York. These were examples of the unusual items that make a day in the cycle trade so interesting.

Remember, every wheel will be custom-built for you, to your orders. Can we say – Wheel be seeing you?
