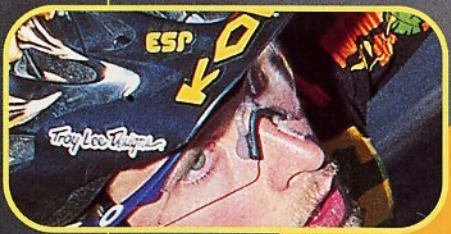

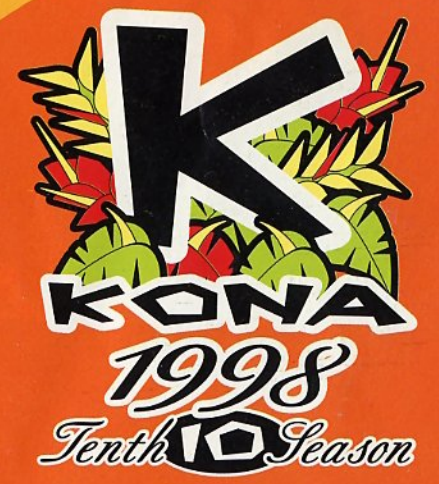

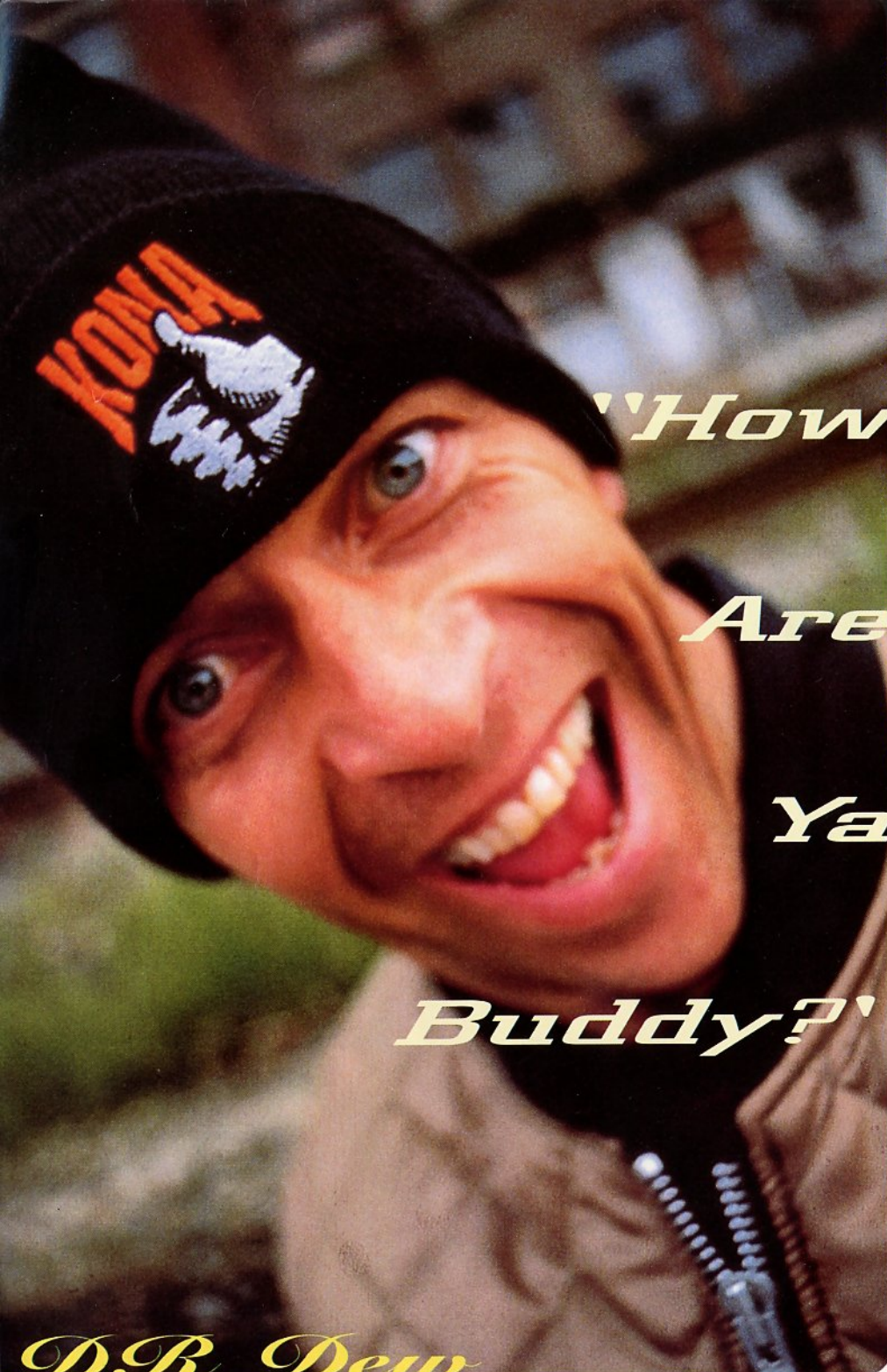

So the bikes are uncomplicated, don't have a lot of tubes pointing in a lot of directions, don't have a lot of pivot points....that didn't bother us when we missed out on the "Oversized Elevated Aluminum" trend a few years back...Maybe we missed out on a few trendy Mountain Bike magazine covers, but that's not the point is it....Gotta make the ride balanced, the bike easy to service, have a design that works for fun or transport (did you wonder what those threaded holes in the dropouts of your King Kahuna were for...yeah...to mount fenders & racks), test & ride everything so that you know it's gonna work, don't stick your neck out on unproven ideas that are going to cost the riders extra money. Keep it simple and the beauty of the ride will take care of itself.

Our Design Team were pioneers of mountain biking, riding the trails of the Pacific Northwest since '74. They still ride everyday, even getting to work within Vancouver's city limits the single track is daunting. Commuting doesn't get much better than this.

The frame design, the combination of long sloping top tube, small rear triangle and long head tube has produced a ride that is unique. Our bikes are fast, inspire confidence and are rated world wide as the best for single track. We invest more in frame material than our competitors, that's why when you register ownership you will receive a life time frame warranty.

Buck a Bike: We believe that riders and the cycle industry should work together to make the World a more bike friendly place. So we are contributing £1 to Sustrans for every Kona sold in the U.K.

Note: Choose your bike by concentrating on the reach rather than the nominal size. Remember that a long and open riding position is the most comfortable when on the trail. Always ask for a test ride.

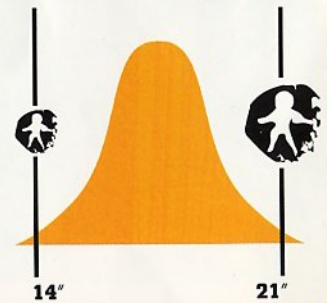
