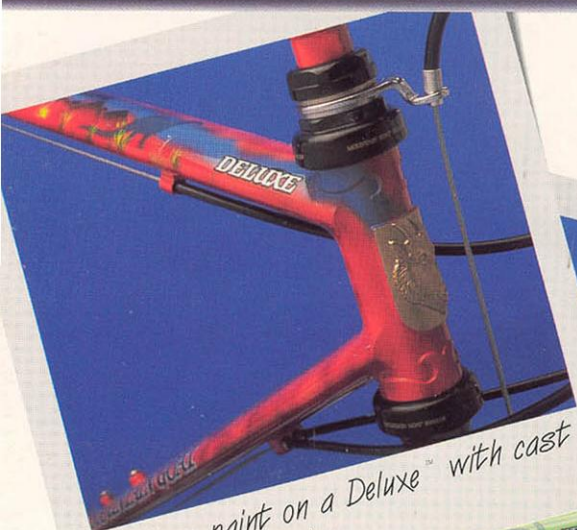

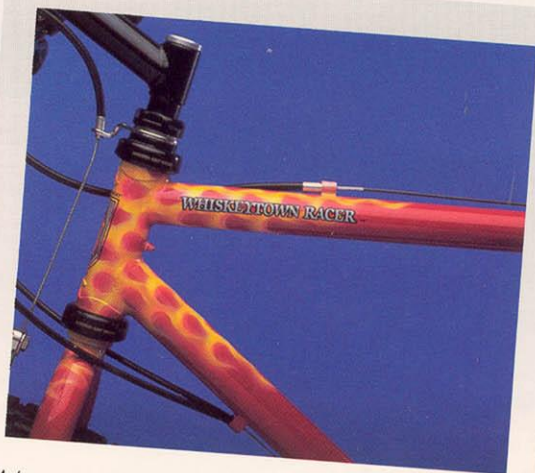
Simply put, it's one of the last great, hand-crafted mountain bikes available.

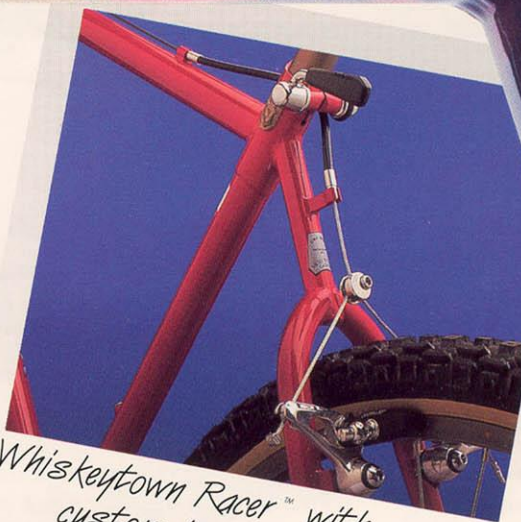
Which means if a hand-crafted mountain bike with a one-of-a-kind paint job is what you seek, you have two choices:

In January of 1981, when the only other mountain bikes were being built by people like Ritchey and Fisher, Jeff Lindsay crafted the first Mountain Goats.

Now, nearly a decade later, Mountain Goats are among the last of the original hand-crafted mountain bikes. Because while others have gone to off-shore factories in a quest for greater profits, Jeff Lindsay and his extraordinary company still produce one-of-a-kind mountain bikes in Chico, California.

They're the finest bikes available.

Each frame is meticulously hand-crafted. (Perhaps because Jeff builds many of them himself.)

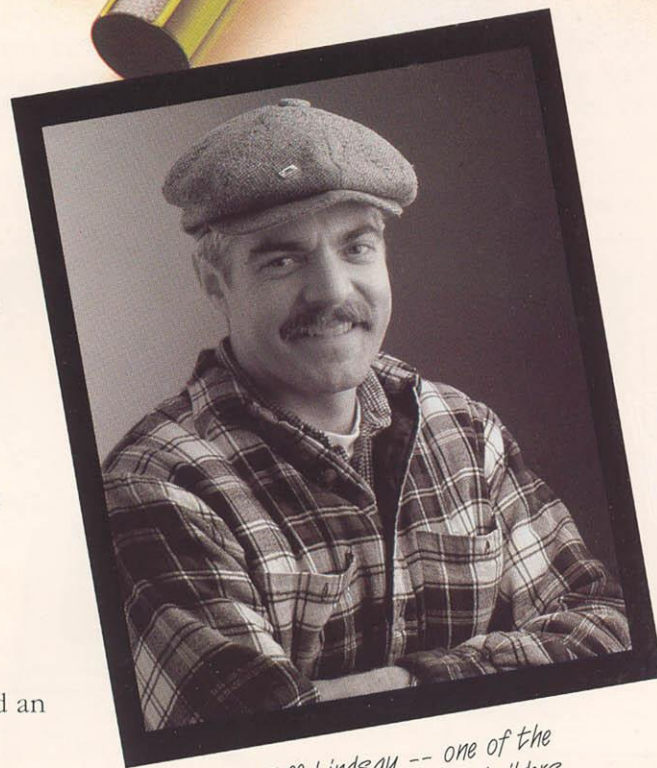
They're the best-handling bikes on the mountain. (Jeff rides them too.)

Finally, our paint jobs are the most creative, most original available anywhere, bar none. (You expected an ordinary paint job from an art major?)

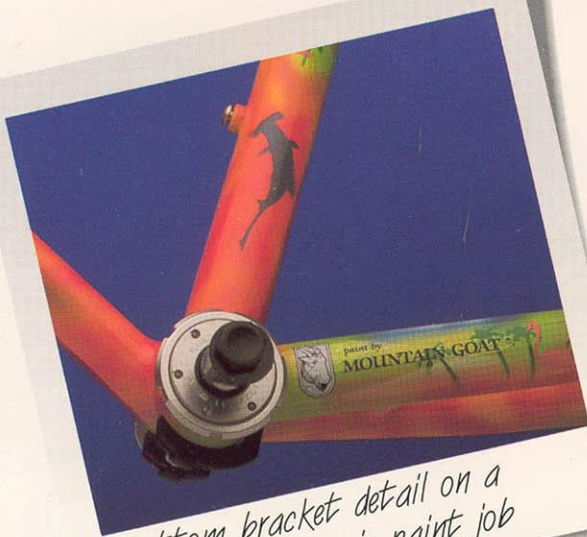
In short, they're still Mountain Goats.

Specifications

A short word about our frame specifications. Every Mountain Goat frame geometry is designed with the optimum ride and performance in mind. We want your bike to be agile, yet comfortable enough to ride all day long. And since we specialize in very small or large sizes, we strive very hard to preserve the "ride and feel" of a Mountain Goat, no matter what size you may need. Mountain Goats have 73 degree seat tubes, 71 degree head tubes (except the Deluxe™, which is 70°), 17" chainstays, and 11⁵/₁₆" bottom brackets.

Naturally, we can build your bike anyway you want it. Just let us know what kind of brakes, braze-ons, and accessories you plan on using and we will build you the best, and prettiest, bike you've ever ridden.
